ArcGIS Desktop software is an integrated system that includes all the tools needed to get the most out of a GIS. This 5 day course provides understanding of a range of functionality and tools available in the ArcGIS software for visualizing, creating, managing geographic data, and performing geoprocessing analysis. You will practice with the ArcMap and ArcCatalog interfaces; learn how to perform common GIS tasks and workflows such as creating and managing geographic data, displaying data on maps in different ways, and combining and analyzing data to discover patterns and relationships. By the end of the course, you will be prepared to start working with the software on your own.

Who should attend?

This course is designed for those with a background in GIS; but would like to acquire the skills in ArcGIS. - Create quality maps.
- Analyzing GIS data using geoprocessing tools and model builder.
